



Brick producer expands

A brick producer in Mpumalanga is growing significantly.

Komatipoort-based Nkomazi Bricks general manager, Ted Repinga, is optimistic of long-term expansion for the brick producer. "We have maintained steady growth since our establishment in 1996, and I believe that future growth in this market largely depends on word-of-mouth. As investment in infrastructural development continues to rise, I am optimistic that Nkomazi Bricks will remain a front-runner in the local region, having maintained a strong reputation for quality and reliability."

Moving forward, Repinga points out that Nkomazi Bricks also plans to increase its stockpile of

bricks to ensure faster turnaround times for customers. "I have full confidence that this can be achieved by continuing to work in close partnership with PMSA for the foreseeable future," he says.

The company has been manufacturing its products using the PMSA RE600 block machine for the past six years, and is in the process of ordering another one to boost production capacities.

Features of the PMSA RE600 block machine include a 2,2 kW twin shaft vibrator with hydraulically operated mould, tamper, feeder box and palletfeeder. The RE600 is available as either a manually operated machine or automated PLC controlled. ■
